Wilmington Christian School has adopted the following statement as defining its doctrinal basis:

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God for faith and practice.
2. We believe that there is one sovereign God, externally existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that for salvation of lost and sinful men, one must be saved by the ministry of God’s Holy Spirit.
5. We believe in the present indwelling ministry of the Holy Spirit, whose intercessory and sanctifying work continually renews the Christian and enables him to live a godly life in conformity with the Scripture.

6. **We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: they who are saved unto the resurrection of life and they who are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.**
7. **We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.**
8. **We believe that God created the family unit as one man and one woman, given in marriage, and recognized before God and man as faithful to one another.**
9. **We do not support or encourage the gay, lesbian, or homosexual life-style.**
10. **We do not support or encourage abortion.**
