



Pre-K Admissions Health Requirements

- **Physical**

All students entering Wilmington Christian School must have a pre-admission physical. A form is provided by WCS for this purpose. The **Student Physical Form** is included in the enrollment contract packet. It is also available from the school nurse and online at the WCS website under Admissions/Application Process/Forms. It is preferred that this form be used as it will provide all of the information that is required for each student. State law requires that a physical be on file for each student *before* a child starts classes. The physical can be no older than one year prior to school entrance.

- **Screening**

A TB test done by the PPD/Mantoux method must be included with the physical. The results of the TB test must be recorded by a nurse or physician. The testing can be no older than 1 year before school entrance. As an *alternative*, the physician may complete a *TB risk assessment* and record the findings on the physical form.

Blood lead screening—usually done at the age of 12 months or after pre-school age years

- **Immunizations**

Immunizations must be up-to-date for age. Generally for pre-school a student should have received:

- 4 doses of DPT

- 3 to 4 doses of OPV/IPV

- 1 dose of MMR

- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine

- 1 dose Varicella vaccine or record of Chicken Pox disease

Additional immunizations are usually given just before Kindergarten and will be required at the time of entrance into that grade. If your child attends Kindergarten at WCS, a new physical and TB test will not be required; only an immunization update is necessary.
