

Middle School Summer Reading Entering Grade 8

### **Summer Reading and Assignments:**

Both assignments are averaged together as one test grade for English. The averages are listed below.

1. 50% A book, of your choice, based on the **Holocaust**. It can be fiction or nonfiction, but must be at least 150 pages long. You may not read *The Diary of Anne Frank* or *The Boy in the Striped Pajamas*.

*Oral Presentation:* Your oral report must be 3-5 minutes. You must include the author, the title, a summary of the plot, and your personal recommendation. State whether you recommend this book, why or why not? You may use notecards!

Be prepared the third day of school to share your oral report with the class.

### 2. 50% Historical Fiction: Choose either of these novels:

Brother's Keeper by Julie Lee OR God's Smuggler by Brother Andrew OR Peace Child by Don Richardson

During the second week of school, students will write an "on-demand" essay (essay that is written completely <u>in class</u>) in response to the essay prompt provided below. Because students will have ample time to prepare for this essay, no notes will be permitted while writing the on-demand essay. Students will have an entire class period to write an introduction, at least two body paragraphs, and a conclusion.

### **Essay Prompt:**

How is your life **similar to** and how is it **different from** the life of the characters in your chosen historical fiction novel? Write an essay with an introduction, at least 2 body paragraphs, and a conclusion that answers this question. Be sure to be very specific.

<b>Focus:</b> Includes a thesis that <i>clearly</i> and <i>fully</i> addresses the prompt; all content effectively supports the thesis statement	5	
<b>Content:</b> Provides detailed support for points and demonstrates evidence of having read the book	15	
<b>Organization</b> : Presents a logical sequence of ideas connected by effective transitions	10	
<b>Mechanics:</b> Uses complete sentences & all handwriting is legible	10	
<b>Length:</b> Essay consists of an introduction, at least 2 body paragraphs, and a conclusion	10
